**Good Friday ~ April 19~ 12 noon Stations ~ 3:00 pm Good Friday Service**

**Holy Saturday ~ April 20~ Easter Vigil ~ 8:30 pm**

**(There is NO 5:15 Mass on April 20th)**

**Easter Sunday ~ April 21 ~8:30 am & 11:00 am**
