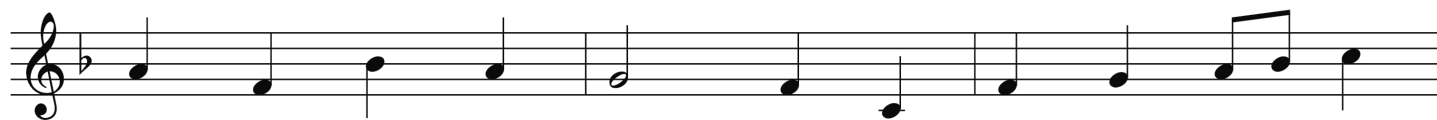

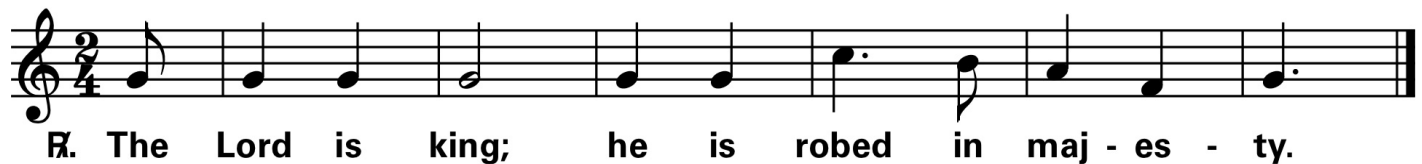
A reading from the Book of the prophet Daniel (DN 7:13-14)

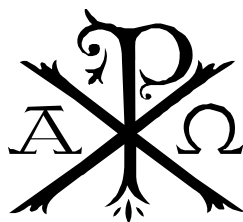

PROFESSION OF FAITH

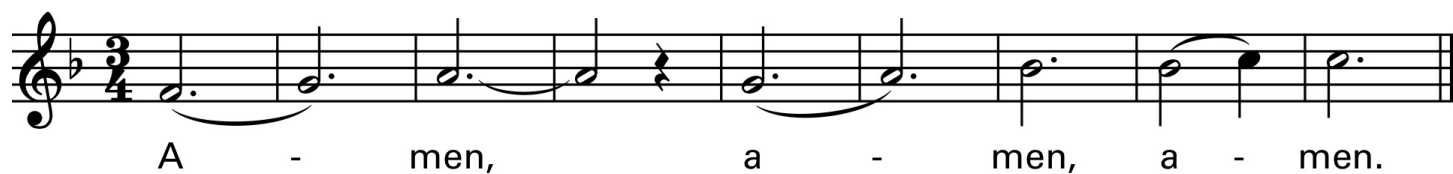



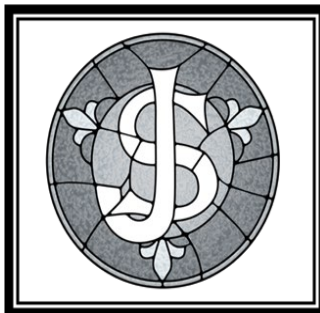
