Review of previous minutes

Monday, October 22, 2018, 6:00 p.m. Members Present: Fr. Ryan Harpole, Fr. Gary Clark, Deacon Larry Conrad, Wayne Nicholson, Lynne Hutcheson, Buzz Coburn, Charlotte Smith, Francisco Flores, Kim Phelps

Finance:

- Fr. Ryan opened with prayer
- Previous month's minutes were reviewed and accepted
- Financial report of accounts statements reviewed
- Prospective properties were inspected with mainly good reviews. SKY property management is seeking to fill vacancy. Rent from both properties would be collected and returned to building fund
- Scott, Murphy, Daniel to send out restoration bids by mid-November
- New webpage up and running. Brochures are to be made about restoration project and online giving possibilities
- \$3600 grant given for Bishop Barron study materials in English and Spanish

Faith Formation:

- Youth group averages 15 kids each Monday beginning with evening prayer in the shrine at 6:00 p.m.
- RCIA has about 10 people in the program
- Faith Formation programs are full. Discussion was made about continuing education opportunities for parents of children in faith formation. Fr. Ryan
- Discussed a "rector's conference" – 20-30 minutes/once a month for parents as a refresher course of sorts

Maintenance and Grounds:

- A fence was built, a tree felled, a fence row was cleared, and a walk-way laid at rectory
- EOA cleared the church of any air quality violations
- The MEALS ministry was discussed and it was suggested that we ask the 12 participating churches in the program to contribute \$2500 each for the remodeling of the parish hall kitchen

Liturgy:

- There will be a liturgy planning committee meeting October 27th at 10:00 a.m. in the youth room
- There will be no Spanish Mass on October 27th
- All Saints Holy Day schedule begins with a vigil @ 6:00 p.m. in English; Nov. 1 @ 7:00 a.m. and 6:30 p.m. in Spanish
- Thanksgiving Mass will be at 8:00 a.m.

Community Life:

- Almost all the tickets for the reverse raffle have been sold. Youth will come early to set up for the event

- Town hall meetings were recapped and there was a good turnout
- 20 gatekeepers were added to list of volunteers in new ministries

- A ramp fitted with a wheelchair lift is to be included in the plans
