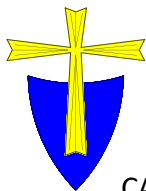

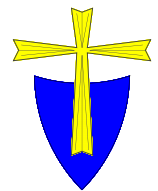

CADA is seeking new members and an athletic director. Anyone within the parish is invited to become a member of CADA. We typically meet 6 times a year plus plan for, and conduct, the annual reverse raffle, and Lenten fish fries.

The athletic director position entails being the adult coordinator of parish athletics. The ideal candidate should be organized, able to communicate effectively, and someone who cares about the well-being of kids. The athletic director is a paid position.

It is not necessary to possess knowledge of the rules of the games to be the athletic director. The position is more focused on communication with the Diocesan CYO office with registering St. Richard teams & players for each sport, ensuring coaches certifications are maintained, and ordering equipment, as necessary. The position does require attending an initial CYO Certification session and maintaining CYO Certification status, through the Diocese of Toledo.
