

MEMBER PROFILE BR. RICHARD FAMULARE

I was born in New York City (Queens) and went to a Catholic Grammar School and a Public High School. After Graduation, I went to NYCCC College for 1 ½ years, Majoring in Electrical Engineering, where I meet my sweetheart and wife, Judy, of 53 years. After deciding that the Major I chose in college was not what I wanted, I left college and joined AT&T in NYC in 1966. After 7 months, I was drafted into the US Army. I was stationed at Fort Benning, GA and Fort Hood, Texas. I was trained as a Radio Repairman and spent most of my time repairing communications equipment on Tanks and Armored Personal Carriers for the 2nd Armored Division in Ft. Hood. I worked my way up to Specialist 5th Class before leaving the Army. I returned to AT&T in 1968, as they held a job position as a technician for me while serving. Judy and I were married one year later and moved to New Jersey in 1969, where we remained until 2021. We had our first Daughter, Susan in January of 1971 and our second daughter, Julie Ann, in December of 1974. Susan still lives in NJ with her Husband and two daughters and purchased our NJ home in August 2021. Julie moved to Parrish, FL in 2021 where she has happily settled in. I joined the local Knights of Columbus in NJ in 2018 and transferred to Council 13341 in December 2021.

During my 33 years with AT&T, I rose to a position of Director of International Products & Services, which included significant Overseas travel, resulting in lost family time. I retired in 1998, at the age of 51, to have more family time, while continuing to consult with AT&T for two more years. After a brief retirement, I took a position with an overseas communications company operating in the US, for the next 9+ years.
