It was the 3rd event held at the Sheridan each with its own theme. There were 40-50 people in attendance. We decorated the room and provided flags for everyone to wave. We passed out bags containing a gift card, candy and patriotic items donated in part by Tidewell Hospice and the Knights of Columbus. 3 Tidewell Hospice Therapy Clowns were present and entertained everyone during the program. The program began with SK John Joly welcoming and introducing everyone followed by the presentation of the Colors by SK & CCC Larry Simmons & SK Carmine Maida.
