# **Faithful Navigators Message**

## Greetings Fellow Knights,

Maundy Thursday - also called Holy Thursday, is the beginning of the three day celebration of Easter - the most important time in the year for Catholics.

Maundy Thursday is the Thursday before Easter. Catholics remember it as the day of the Last Supper, when Jesus washed the feet of his disciples. Maundy actually means the washing of the feet of the poor.

Holy Thursday is possibly one of the most important, complex, and profound days of celebration in the Catholic Church. Holy Thursday celebrates the institution of the Eucharist as the true body and blood of Jesus Christ and the institution of the sacrament of the priesthood.

During the Last Supper, Jesus offers himself as the Passover sacrifice, the sacrificial lamb, and teaches that every ordained priest is to follow the same sacrifice in the exact same way. Christ also bids farewell to his followers and prophesizes that one of them will betray him and hand him over to the Roman soldiers. Then later that night, Judas betrayed Jesus in the Garden of Gethsemane.

At the Last Supper, He broke bread with the apostles and said "Take this, all of you and eat from it. For this is the Body of Christ......so that your sins may be forgiven. Do this in memory of me". And then he took the cup......."so that your sins may be forgiven. Do this in memory of me".

I wonder if the apostles understood at that time that Jesus knew his own death was coming. And that's why he said, "do this in memory of me". It is our belief is that Jesus died on the cross to wash away Mankind's sins. He established the Eucharist to give those He left behind a symbolic way to remember Him for what He did for us.

So now when Holy Thursday comes this year, you will now understand the true meaning of Holy Thursday or Maundy Thursday. FN Jeff Filippi
