We need between 18 and 22 volunteers for each game. There are 17 games on the schedule for this year starting on Sunday February 23rd and ending on Monday March 23rd. Attached is the full schedule. The time listed on the schedule is 1/2 hour before the Gates of the Stadium open...the time we should report. You will receive a parking pass, Knights cap (if you don't already have one) and a tee shirt (again if you don't already have one). 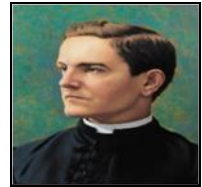

White Crosses



Each year, 150 white crosses are deployed along FL SR 70 on the property of Our Lady of the Angeles Parish in Bradenton, FL by the Knights of Council 13341. The intent of this deployment is to bring the community's attention to the absolute need to repeal the murderous Supreme Court Roe v Wade ruling in 1973 while at once making the statement that each of the 150 crosses represents 425,000 innocents taken before birth by abortion since the Roe v Wade decision. Construction, maintenance, deployment, recovery and storage of the crosses have been the key components of this annual commitment by Council 13341 since 2010.

The project team completed the following tasks:

- **Assisted with completing installation of trusses and fascia.**
- **Complete landscaping tasks in preparation of laying sod:**
 - **Rake and shovel debris from lot to container.**
 - **Shovel dirt from high to low areas.**
 - **Pitch lot from foundation outward to allow proper drainage.**
- Remove and store tools**

This activity was coordinated by DGK John Joly, the Knights of Columbus Program Director and Habitat Chair. This represented the 1st Habitat project in 2020 and cumulatively the 37th monthly project in a row since January of 2017.
