Fries and offered Baked Ziti and garlic Bread as an alternative to the Fish. We changed fish products halfway through the event based on feedback we received. We changed from a pre breaded beer batter fish to a fish that we battered by hand with a more traditional breading which was extremely well received. Almost half of our business was takeout/to go meals and the other half being dine in. In addition the Women's Guild sold desserts on two tables also in SSH.

We had one table in center of room for Cole Slaw and two tables set up but one kitchen entrance that we used for takeout/to go station prep. We had two cashiers inside on one table and two cashiers outside entrance to all 3 SHH's to handle take out orders.

Financial results were disappointing based on the amount of effort from the brothers and guests that worked the event. Next year we will have a better fish product with taste panels held in advance with Council leadership to settle on final fried fish offered. It is also recommended that we do not offer Baked Ziti as it was expensive to prepare and tough to control how much was made as it had to be prepped and made in advance.






Legislation that would ban abortions as early as six weeks — before many women know they are pregnant and let virtually any private citizen sue abortion providers and others was given final approval by law-

makers and is headed to Gov. <u>Greg Abbott</u>, who has signaled he will sign it into law.

Senate Bill 8, a Republican priority measure, is similar to "heartbeat bills" passed in other states that have been mostly stopped by the courts. But proponents of the Texas legislation believe it's structured in a way that makes it tougher to block.
