Habitat Going Postal!

On Thursday, July 14th, 2022, 7 Knights of Council #13341 teamed together with Habitat for Humanity at the Habitat Depot in Palmetto

The project team completed the following tasks:

Set up drop cloths, wooden horses, several power hand sanders and mixed several gallons of primer paint to be applied to porch posts.

Rough sanded 12 full length and 4 half-length wood porch posts. Filled in all defects then fine sanded posts to high quality finish for future installation at several new home construction sites.

Applied one coat of primer paint to all porch posts. Posts stored in Depot upon completion of painting.

Cleaned area. Washed/ cleaned all painting materials, including drop cloths. Stored all equipment, including power sanders, for future use.

This activity was coordinated by Michael Mahan, Habitat for Humanity Chairman. This represented the 7th Habitat project in 2022 and cumulatively the 67th monthly project in a row (68 total projects over the same time frame) since January 2017.

Every Drop Counts!

The Knights of Columbus Council 13341 in association with One Blood held a blood drive at

Our Lady of Angels Catholic Church on Thursday July 21, 2022 from 12noon - 6pm. One Blood provided two Bloodmobiles which allowed us to have significant, non-snowbird-season results. We had 40 donors participating and providing 34 pints of blood to serve our local community. OneBlood had a goal of 30 pints! Each donation can save up to three lives, so that means 102 patients could benefit from the lifesaving efforts of the blood donors from this drive.

There was rush of donors at the beginning of the event. Donors were sparse towards the end of the event. There were 8 walkups. There was only one donor that had to wait 5 minutes to donate! We handled each donor as they arrived.


