What we accomplished

On Thursday, June 20th, 2019, 7 Knights of Council 13341 teamed together at a Critical Home Repair in Bradenton, FL.

The project team (aka Habitat Dream Team) completed the following tasks in preparation for painting the home:

- Removed weeds and swept debris from concrete surfaces.
 - Removed the shutters.
 - Trimmed back bushes from around the sidewalls of the house.
 - Pressure washed the exterior of the house and surrounding concrete surfaces.
 - Dug down around the outside walls of the house to allow for painting of the foundation bottom.
- Finished caulking that was needed.

This activity was coordinated by DGK John Joly, the Knights of Columbus Program Director and Habitat Chair. This represented the 6th Habitat project in 2019 and cumulatively the 30th project in a row since January of 2017.

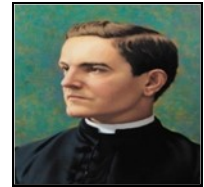

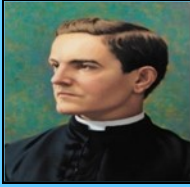

For The Good of the Order

Planned Parenthood clinics nationwide have stopped using federal Title X family planning funds, according to the organization.

The decision comes after the Trump administration announced this week that it has started enforcing regulations that prohibit Title X grant recipients from counseling patients about abortion.

The Trump administration's rules – unveiled last year and finalized this year – forbid groups that provide or refer patients for abortion from receiving funds through Title X, which pays for reproductive health care for about 4 million low-income people.

Heartbeat bills prohibit abortion once a fetal heartbeat can be detected. But reproductive rights advocates and doctors say the laws, which prohibit abortion before many women know they are pregnant, amount to a near-total ban on the procedure. Could be the end of Roe V Wade because the court would establish fetuses are human and protected under the Constitution.
