The Fisher House™ is "a home away from home" for families and Caregivers of patients receiving medical care at major military and VA Medical Centers. The homes are normally located within walking distance of the treatment facility or have transportation available. There are over 70 Fisher Houses located on military installations and VA medical centers.

A Military Trivia Contest was held, quickly followed by some lively musical entertainment provided by **Marc Anthony**, himself a Military Police Officer stationed in Washington DC. After a rousing rendition of all the branches of the US Military he moved into current favorites which brought a crowd to the dance floor.

Our Assembly also donated generously from our night's proceeds to the Fisher House.
