Al was born in the Bronx New York and grew up in the boro of Queens, he attended Nativity BVM Elementary School in Ozone Park, and the Bishop Loughlin in Bedford Stuyvesant, Brooklyn. He obtained his AA degree from Kingsborough CC in Brooklyn, NY. He meet his lovely wife in 1971 and they were married in 1973, they are celebrating 50 years of Marriage June 3rd. At that time Al was a court officer with the City of New York. Al left the court system and went to work for a division of Equifax working as a Private Investigator for them, he continues to hold and active PI license in Florida.

Al and Sue welcomed the first of their two daughter Maria in February 1977 and the next year they relocated to Southington, CT so Al could expand Equifax's investigative unit in that State. After a year in Southington it was back to Equfax in NY and the purchase of their home in Holbrook, NY. They welcomed there second Daughter Michele in August 1980. Al became a Knight then and Sue a Columbiette, shortly after joining the Knights, Al became a 4th Degree member and the Grand Knight of his council and also a District Warden.
