#### Purpose of the Color Corp

When knighthood was in flower, knights carried the sword to defend their God, their Church, their country and their fellow man according to the code of chivalry. Today, Sir Knights wear regalia and carry the sword to honor Christ and His apostles, especially on religious and civic occasions. Hence, the primary purpose of the Fourth Degree is to encourage active Catholic citizenship and foster the spirit of patriotism in members and the community at large.

The Color Corps members exemplify all the principles of our Order:

**Charity** – by the gift of their time and energies necessary to practice, perfect and perform the ceremonials and sword drill;

**Unity** – by the united efforts of Sir Knights to practice and perfect a coordinated drill for the good of the Church and the Order;

**Fraternity** – by expressing an “Esprit de Corps,” sharing a common desire for drill excellence and camaraderie; and

**Patriotism** – by performing precision drill as a salute to God and to country and visually exhibiting a love for both.

### Burial For Veteran with no Family



On Monday, September 19th, 6 Knights and 2 Knight's Wives from San Damiano Assembly attended a service at the Sarasota National Cemetery for a Veteran with no family present. The Veteran served honorably as a nurse in the Air Force. She retired after 20 years and achieved the rank of Lieutenant Colonel.

There were 3 Assemblies present totaling 28 Sir Knights, along with several Veteran organizations including an Air Force Honor Guard who presented the Veterans flag and performed a three-volley salute, which represents duty, honor, and country. The salute was performed by a rifle party from the Honor Guard, consisting of three members. During the salute, the rifle party aims their rifles in a direction over the casket and fires blank cartridges into the air three times in unison. Taps, the bugle call played at military funerals, was played directly following the three-volley salute.

71 people were present at the ceremony. Worthy RA Bob Marrow attended and took photos of the service. SK Bob has been leading a KofC Fourth Degree effort for more than 12 years where volunteers attend Veteran Funerals at Sarasota National. They currently have a ceremony once per month to highlight Veterans who have been buried the previous month with no family present. The Assembly has attended more than 1,000 funerals since starting. SK Brother Bob maintains a contact list of more than 90 volunteers and typically, they get 15 to 20 members each month to participate.
