### MEMBER PROFILE



Lieutenant Colonel Paul Gulbrandsen was born in Albany, N.Y., in 1971. He enlisted in the Marine Corps reserves in March of 1990 and served as a tank crewman on the M60 & M1A1 tanks while attending college. LtCol Gulbrandsen was commissioned in June 1994, after graduating from the College at Brockport: State University of New York.

His supporting establishment tours include: Marine Corps Base Hawaii, where he served as the Deputy Disbursing officer, while congruently holding the billet of Service Company Executive officer; Parris Island, S.C., where he supervised recruit training as a Series Commander, Company Executive Officer and Company Commander; and Manpower and Reserve Affairs, in Quantico, Va., where he served as the Marine Corps Compensation Chief and the Manpower Programs Officer responsible for ensuring fiscal resources were properly applied to future manpower budgets.

He has served as an Assistant Chief of Staff, Comptroller at every level of command in the Fleet Marine Corps. His operational tours include 1st Marine Division, 2nd Marine Aircraft Wing, First Marine Expeditionary Force (I MEF), Regional Command South Westin Afghanistan and now U.S. Marine Corps Forces, Central Command. During his time in the Fleet Marine Corps he deployed three times in support of Operations Iraqi Freedom I & II, and Operation Enduring Freedom.

LtCol Gulbrandsen is a graduate of the Marine Corps Financial Management School, Marine Corps Amphibious Warfare School, United States Naval War College and the DoD Professional Military Comptroller School. He holds an M.B.A. from Webster University and a Masters of Arts in National Security & Strategic Studies from the United States Naval War College.

LtCol Gulbrandsen is married to the former Angela M. Salas and has three children; Jessica, age 18, Vincent, age 16, and Toni Marie, age 15.
