## 2 Scope

This policy is part of St. Paul Lutheran Church's organizational policies. This policy applies to gifts of \$1,000 or more to St. Paul, donated outside of the offering envelope.

---

## 3 Policy

If money is donated to the church for \$1,000 or more and the donor does not designate what the money is for, it will be distributed as follows:

- 50% Capital Improvement Fund
- 30% General Endowment Fund
- 10% Home Missions
- 10% General Operating Budget

If money is donated for under \$1,000 and the donor does not designate what it is for, it will go to the General Operating Budget.

This allocation will be reviewed annually in July, in consideration of the annual budget.

These rules do not apply to money that is given through the offering plate. That money will go to the general operating budget, unless otherwise designated.
