From the Diocese...

Dear Friends in the Lord,

The season of Lent begins this year on Ash Wednesday, February 18, 2026, and ends just prior to the evening Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday, April 2, 2026, when the Paschal Triduum begins. Lent is the principal penitential season in the Church year. All the Christian faithful are urged to develop and maintain a voluntary program of self-denial (in addition to the Lenten regulations which follow), serious prayer and the performing of deeds of charity and mercy, including the giving of alms.

LENTEN REGULATIONS –

1. **ABSTINENCE** – Everyone 14 years of age and over is bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays of Lent.

2. **FAST** – Everyone 18 years of age and under 59 is required to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. On these two days of fast and abstinence, only one full meatless meal is permitted. Two other meatless meals, sufficient to maintain strength may be taken according to each person's needs, but together these two should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids (including milk and fruit juices) are allowed. 3. To disregard completely the law of fast and abstinence is seriously sinful.

May this holy season be a time of spiritual renewal for each of us!

We will hold anointing of the sick during Mass on Feb. 22nd. Please know that anointing is not just for serious illness or dying, spiritual healing, physical healing, and comfort and peace are also included.

The primary effects of the Anointing of the Sick include: **Spiritual Healing:** The sacrament provides forgiveness of sins and strengthens the sick person spiritually, helping them to face their illness with hope and faith.

Physical Healing: While not guaranteed, the sacrament may also lead to physical healing if it is God's will.

Comfort and Peace: Recipients often experience a profound sense of peace and comfort, knowing they are supported by the Church and God's grace.
