A Message from Fr. Peter

Lent – Let's Journey Together with Christ in the Wilderness!

Lent begins officially on Ash Wednesday, February 14, 2024. There are many things to keep in mind this beautiful season. But let us start with the details of our parish Lenten experience this year. These details cover our two parishes – St. Isidore and Our Lady of the Holy Spirit.

On Ash Wednesday, we shall have a 5:30 PM Mass at Our Lady of the Holy Spirit and a 7:00 PM Mass at St. Isidore. At both Masses, ashes will be distributed. I am celebrating a noon Mass at the Piling Chapel of Millikin University for those who prefer an earlier Mass on Ash Wednesday. That gives us a third opportunity to participate in this year's Ash Wednesday experience.

As we begin this Lenten experience, I want to remind us about the three critical virtues that the Church emphasizes during the season of Lent. These are almsgiving, prayer, and fasting. During Lent, we shall have a special evening of confession and reflection on these virtues. We shall schedule one for each of our two parishes. We shall also have stations of the cross every week in both parishes. In Bethany, we shall have Stations of the Cross at 5:00 PM every Thursday, followed by our usual 5:30 PM Mass. The stations of the cross in Bethany shall replace our 5:00 PM Adoration and Confessions. At Mount Zion, we shall have our stations of the cross at 6:30 PM every Friday, followed by Adoration and Rosary.

I encourage us to participate in these Lenten activities and take every opportunity to deepen our relationship with Christ. Lent is a particular season of introspection and meditation on the whys of life and the reason for our existence as human beings and as Christians. Take time and resolve what to give up or add up to help achieve a more meaningful Lenten experience. Do not be discouraged by the fact that you have not kept your resolutions well in the previous years and seasons. Try again this time with more commitment and openness to God. And be assured of my prayers for you and your good intentions.
