**LENTEN REGULATIONS**

**ABSTINENCE** – Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence. Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence from meat. This applies to everyone 14 years and older. Fasting regulations are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. Fasting allows a person to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together do not equal to a full meal.
