## *The Pastor's Corner*

**The Installation of a Pastor**

Tomorrow (Monday, July 20) at 6 p.m., the Bishop of Springfield will be with us to offer Mass and install me as Pastor of O.L. of the Holy Spirit and St. Isidore's. You are all invited to attend, but please telephone the parish office to sign up. I don't want to be in a position of violating the current limitations on the church capacity under the very nose of the Bishop.

When a pastor takes canonical possession of his parish, he is required to make a profession of faith and to swear an oath of fidelity. I will give you the highlights of these so that you can see what is required of a pastor and what the faithful have a right to expect from their priests.

The profession of faith requires me to say publicly that I "with firm faith believe and profess everything" contained in the Nicene Creed, which I then recite. I will also profess my faith in all things contained in Sacred Scripture and Sacred Tradition and all that our Holy Mother the Church proposes for our belief. This is very important, because the Faith is an integral whole. We cannot, in other words, hold 95% of the Faith and reject 5%. If we do not hold 100% of the Faith, we have rejected the whole Faith and invented a new religion for ourselves.

I will next swear an oath of fidelity. I will swear always to preserve communion with the Catholic Church. Jesus Christ willed to establish the Catholic Church as the guardian and transmitter of his teachings and his sacraments. It is a very bad thing for anyone willfully and knowingly to put himself outside the pale of Christ's Holy Church, but it is a much worse thing for a priest or bishop, who has responsibility for the souls of others. I then swear to carry out the duties which Church law imposes on a pastor for the good of the souls in his charge. I shall also swear to "hold fast to the deposit of faith in its entirety" and faithfully to hand it on and explain it and to avoid teaching anything contrary to it. I also undertake to follow the discipline of the Church myself and to foster it among the souls committed to my charge.

In short, I undertake nothing less than to be an exemplary priest and pastor of souls. In order to be able to become anything close to this, I shall rely heavily on your prayers, as well as those of Our Blessed Lady and St. Isidore. *Oremus pro invicem.* Let us pray for each other.

If I am the only one in church at 4:15, I will either have to cancel adoration or cancel confessions. If I am faced with that choice, I will always choose to cancel adoration in order to keep the confession time. (This also means that if you are the only adorer, you cannot leave to go to confession.) If ever you arrive and the Blessed Sacrament is not exposed, you can still make your visit with Jesus in the tabernacle.~ Rev. Jason Stone
