PreK - 5th Grade: Our Sunday School Program is a dynamic and engaging beginning to your child's faith formation years. We offer sections of each grade level to meet your child's needs.

The PreK – 5th grade classes meet on most Sunday mornings at St. Peter Catholic School from 9:00 AM to 10:15 AM.



6th - 11th Grade: Program includes 16 core curriculum lessons and six Faith In Action Testimonial (FIAT) experiences. We utilize large and small group discussion formats, youth retreats and service opportunities. Youth will learn and explore ways to apply the faith lessons to their daily lives, walking as disciples of Our Lord, Jesus Christ.

Middle School Program: two Wednesdays per month, 7:00 – 8:30 PM

High School Program: two Mondays per month, 7:00 – 8:30 PM



6th - 11th Grade: Designed for students and families who find it difficult to balance busy school-year schedules: studies, sports, clubs, or any extra-curricular activities. Fulfill your religious education Core Curricular lessons before the school year begins. Curriculum follows traditional school-year program. FIATs can be done throughout the year, must complete 6 FIATs by May 1.

Aug 17-20 & Aug 24-27 High School: 8-11:30 AM / Middle School: 12:30-4 PM

Eligibility: Open to all students entering grades 6 - 11 this coming school year, Grades 7 - 11 must be up to date with FIAT requirements from the previous year.

Program Requisite: minimum of 10 students and a maximum of 30 students per session (HS/MS)

What is FAMILY PROGRAM?

Families grow in the Catholic Faith together.

- Sundays 9 -10:15 AM
- Religious Education / Christian Formation for the whole family.
- Allows parents to renew and build their Catholic faith along with their children.
- **Younger siblings (K-5th grade) still attend Sunday School, while parents and older youth (middle or high school aged kids) attend the Family Faith Formation portion of Family Program.**
- Each Class is designed around a specific faith lesson, and utilizes both large group instruction and small group discussion, with separate adult and youth / grade specific small groups to discuss how to live that faith lesson in our daily lives – at home, at work or school, in recreation.
- Start or finish each class with either 7:30 AM or 10:30 AM Mass as a whole family.

- This program is not only for the children, it also helps us parents renew our beliefs and become stronger Catholics
- Studying our faith together shows my children that my faith is important to me and I want to learn with them; Religious Education isn't something I make them do, it is part of our life as a family.
