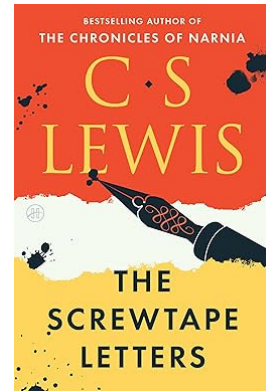

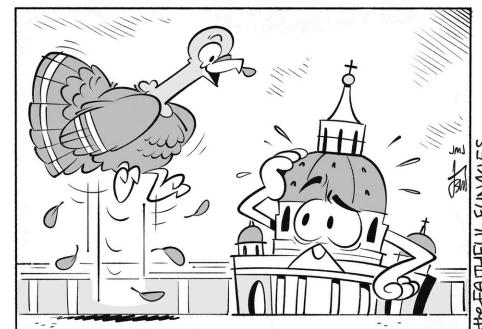

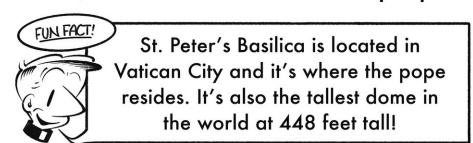
Bring your Bible, a heart open to the Word of God, and a desire to share your experience in Christ as we study the scripture for the upcoming Sunday Gospel.
