



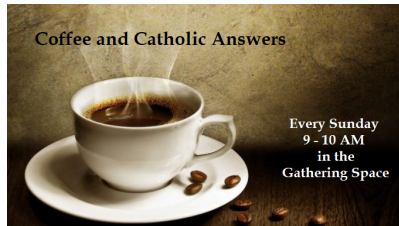

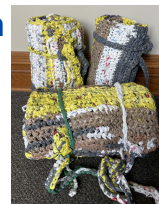
Friends & Frappes

Experience the Love of God in a profound and engaging way; build lasting relationships with other Catholic teens from around the country. The theme this year is "Fearless."

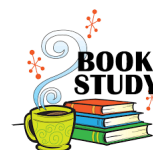
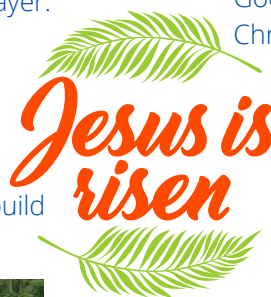
