

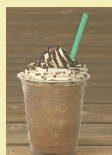

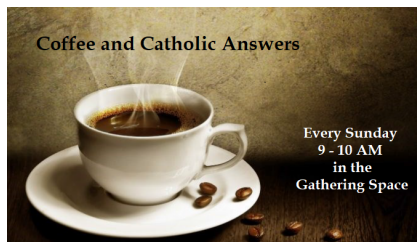


Friends & Frappes

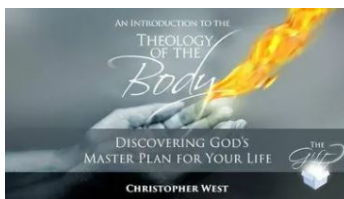

CANS FOR CHARITY

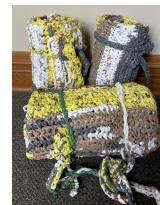
St. Peter Faith Formation has taken up the Aluminum Cans Recycling Project as a Cans for Charity Service Opportunity.

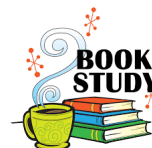
