Things to Bring

As we approach the final stretch before our departure to Maine, you should be preparing items for the trip. Below are a few important things that you must bring with you.

- Sleeping bag, sheet, and pillow.
- Personal toiletries, earplugs (who snores?)
- Towel: bath and beach and bathing suit, sun tan lotion.

- There is no washing machine available.
