
ST JOSEPH CATHOLIC CHURCH HOUSEHOLDS OF FAITH / Religious Ed Handbook—2025/2026

Checklist for Households of Faith Formation

Grades PreK (4 years old) to 8th: Complete the Gospel Weeklies with your family the Sundays you cannot come or there is no class.

Family: Participate in the Family Catechesis Days.

Mass Attendance: Celebrate Sunday Mass as a family.

Mass Journals: Complete and turn in to your teacher at least one Mass Journal a Month.

Prayers: Have memorized the Traditional Catholic Prayers: Our Father, Hail Mary, Glory Be and Act of Contrition.
