Mass Attendance Guidelines:

- Attendance is limited to 500 people (50% of church's occupancy).
- Face masks **must** be worn (per directive from Bishop Frank Dewane).
- Use of hand sanitizer is encouraged before entering the Church.
- Only the Front (Main) doors will be utilized before daily Mass. All four entrances will be used for Sunday/Saturday vigil Masses.
- To allow time for sanitizing between Masses, entrance to the Church will only be allowed 30 minutes prior to Mass. It is suggested parishioners wait in their cars until Church doors have been propped open.
- For those who wish to receive, Communion will be placed only in the hand (not on the tongue; gluten-free hosts will be available upon request).
- All are asked to maintain appropriate social distancing at all times while in Church ... while seated in pews, processing for Communion and entering/exiting the Church. (Markings on the floor will assist you during communion and entering/exiting church.)
- We will continue to do the blessing of the children at Sunday Mass, however, the children will remain in their seats in the pews during the blessing.

- An orderly dismissal at the end of Mass is required – most likely, row-by-row starting from the back of the Church. Your cooperation is most appreciated.
- Pews, door handles, and restrooms will be sanitized between Masses.
- There will be no printed materials in the pews or bulletins distributed.
- There will be no bus or tram service until further notice.
- All those, as defined by the health department, as more vulnerable (i.e. 65 + years of age, those with compromised immune systems, those with underlying health conditions, those who are especially anxious about being in a large group) **are encouraged to stay at home.**
- Anyone with fever or flu-like symptoms **will not be permitted to enter the church.**
- Until further notice, all parish activities remain suspended. This includes Knights of Columbus, Women of St. Joseph, Youth Group, Rosary Groups, table tennis, and any other organized Parish activity other than the Sacred Liturgy at daily & weekend Masses.
- Baptisms, weddings and funerals may resume, following the 50% capacity rule and social distancing considerations.
- **Please note, there is still a risk for anyone who attends a public Mass to contract COVID-19.**
