28 May 2018: Day 1: Cape Town

29 May 2018: Day 2: Cape Town: Cape Peninsula tour

You won't believe the beautiful scenery you will experience in one day on the Cape Peninsula. We will start by driving to the beautiful Atlantic seaside suburbs of Clifton and Camps Bay, and see the Twelve Apostles. We will then take the coastal road past Hout Bay, followed by a scenic drive up Chapman's Peak, one of the best views in the region. We will then travel on to the Cape of Good Hope, the furthest southwestern point in Africa. We will have time for hiking to the Cape Point lighthouse, and have lunch in the Nature Reserve. On our way back, we will take the scenic route back to Cape Town via Vishoek and Muizenberg, popping in at Boulders Beach to view the Penguin Colony and stopping for a wine tasting at Groot Constantia.

30 May 2018: Day 3: Cape Town – Hermanus – Cape Agulhas

We depart from Cape Town for Hermanus We follow the scenic coastal road, stopping at Betties Bay to view a colony of endangered African penguins. You can spend the afternoon in the seaside resort town of Hermanus, famous for hundreds of Southern Right Whales during the whale season (July to November) and many shops, restaurants and markets. In the afternoon we will drive on to Cape Agulhas, the most southern tip of Africa, where we visit a viewpoint known as the "real" place where the Indian and Atlantic Oceans meet.

31 May 2018: Day 4: Cape Agulhas - Mossel Bay - Knysna/Wilderness

After breakfast we will stop in Mossel Bay to spend some time on the spectacular beaches, hike the Cape St. Blaize trail along the cliffs overlooking the Indian Ocean, and visit the famous Diaz Museum complex, commemorating the first known European exploration around the tip of Africa. In the afternoon we will drive on to Wilderness/Knysna where we will overnight.

1 June 2018: Day 5: Knysna/Wilderness – Tsitsikamma - Addo

Today we travel to Tsitsikamma National Park. We will spend the morning in Tsitsikamma National Park with its unique combination of indigenous forest and beautiful Indian Ocean coastline. The park has a wide choice of activities for all, including hiking, crossing a suspension bridge and swimming. In the afternoon we will leave the Garden Route for Big 5 country, Addo.

a dinner destination, possibly a cattle farm, which is a brewery and diner or a diner overlooking the beach.

Christine and John will shop, prepare, and serve for everyone the Co-workers will also be invited along with the staff from Simunye Day Care Centre. This will be celebration of God's plan for our future relationship and a time to say " phinde ndikubone" or "see you again" in Xhosa.
