Meeting began at 7:10 p.m. Opening prayer led by Father

### Old Business

#### Church

- Church clock face(s). Was the Eagle Activities Assoc. reached out to for assistance/ideas for funding help by anyone yet? – Cris will contact Chris Lauterbach if was brought up to them yet.

#### Krause Project

- Finished

#### Projects Completed

- “No Parking” sign removed on school parking lot thanks to John. Someone with hacksaw can cut cement blocks off railing parts, then recycle metal from sign. Blocks could just be buried in back somewhere.
- “No Parking” signs installed at end of each driveway up to school main entrance, thanks again to John.
- Room attached to Food Pantry has been transformed into a new Bridal room, thanks to Jill, Charity and Judy. Cris will send thank-you to all who volunteered their time, \$ and energy to project. Other room previously used as Bridal room will now hold boxes of Church records currently stored in the upstairs of the rectory.
- Fallen branch from oak tree on school grounds dismembered & removed from driveway by school. Cris contacted “Family Tree” in Eagle at Pete's request to come look at tree to give recommendation and estimate of removal or just trimming. Waiting for response.

### New Business

- Cedar shake disrepair off gable end. Replacement project was approved by Finance Council in 2019, but due to changing financial circumstances with the “Together We Build Campaign” and then with the COVID-19 crisis, it was detained. In the meantime, the pre-painted material that was selected is no longer available. It is now too late in the season to get pre-painted material and complete this fall. Mike made suggestion that maybe we could purchase unpainted material, have volunteers paint, and still have Skyline complete this fall.
- Exterior church windows on East side need little caulking & touch up paint. Mike suggested that if we had Gilbertson do one of window projects they quoted last year, they might take care of this at no charge. Scraping and painting around 2 windows and door on south side of the servers' sacristy was quoted at \$1,275. Restoration of the 4 stained glass windows in stair well of choir loft was \$12,400.

- Main entrance railing to Church has one of the rungs broken off post. Cris's husband was a welder for 40 years, but said would need to be done with a portable welding machine, which he does not have. Cris will contact “Smokey”, who did our inside Church railings, for estimate on repairing.
- Mike suggested with help from Dave Rockteacher and Mike Major, we could put stone border on both sides of sidewalk leading to steps from East parking lot, & then have volunteers lay grass seed & straw to landscape rest.
- All 5 topics above tabled for more input &/or suggestions from missing members until another walk-around meeting scheduled for Sunday, anytime after 12:00 noon, weather permitting.
