

FAMILY PROMISE DAILY TIMETABLE

FIRST SUNDAY

1. Rooms for the Guest Families and the common area are set up prior to the arrival of the families' personal belongings;
2. A Family Promise truck or van arrives in the afternoon with bedding and families' personal belongings;
3. Guest Families arrive at the Host Congregation Sunday evening (5:30 PM);
4. 6:00 PM Dinner is served family style;
5. Guests and volunteers SHARE the meal;
6. After dinner Volunteers fellowship with the Families;
 - a. Play Games;
 - b. Help with Homework;
 - c. Watch Videos; Or
 - d. Just talk;
7. Food for Lunch is available in the kitchen for parents to make sack lunches for the following day;
8. Guests Families are responsible for their children;
9. Guests Families help Volunteers with clean up and chores;
10. Adult Guests turn in around 10:00 PM (guest children at appropriate earlier bedtimes);
11. TWO VOLUNTEERS WILL SPEND THE NIGHT at Host Site.

MONDAY through FRIDAY

1. Breakfast is served around 6:30 AM (typically cereal and other convenient foods);
2. The Family Promise Van picks up the Guest Families at 7:00 AM;
3. The Family Promise Van takes the Guest Families to the Family Center;
 - a. Parents go to their jobs or work with the Family Center Director to seek employment;
 - b. Children go to school;
 - c. The Family Center has SHOWERS, a WASHER & DRYER and other necessities;
4. The Guest Families return to the Host Congregation around 5:30 PM;
5. 6:00 PM Dinner is served family style;
6. Guests and Volunteers SHARE the meal;
7. After dinner Volunteers fellowship with the Guest Families;
 - a. Play Games;
 - b. Help with Homework;
 - c. Watch Videos; Or
 - d. Just talk;
8. Food for Lunch is available in the kitchen for parents to make sack lunches for the following day;
9. Guest Families are responsible for their children;
10. Guest Families help volunteers with clean up and chores;
11. Guest Adults turn in around 10:00 PM (guest children at appropriate earlier bedtimes);
12. Two Volunteers will spend the night at Host Site.

SATURDAY

1. The Guest Families can sleep in and enjoy a hot breakfast;
2. The Guest Families go back to the Family Center (8 AM or so) and do what Families typically do on weekends;
3. The Guest Families return to the Host Congregation around 5:30 PM;
4. 6:00 PM Dinner is served family style;
5. Guests and volunteers SHARE the meal;
6. After dinner Volunteers fellowship with the Guest Families;
 - a. Play Games;
 - b. Help with Homework;
 - c. Watch Videos; Or
 - d. Just talk;
7. Food for Lunch is available in the kitchen for parents to make sack lunches for the following day;
8. Guest Families are responsible for their children;
9. Guest Families help volunteers with clean up and chores;
10. Adults turn in around 10:00 PM (children at appropriate earlier bedtimes);
11. Two Volunteers will spend the night at Host Site.

FOLLOWING SUNDAY

1. Breakfast is served
2. The Guest Families are packed up and out of the Host Facilities prior to Sunday services;
3. The Guest Families are taken to the Family Center for the day and stay until it is time to go to the next Host Site;
4. The Guest Families are taken to the next Host Congregation.
