TOPIC	DISCUSSION
Approval of Minutes	Approved via emails, but Erin pointed out that <u>we need to get better at responding as soon as possible</u> . Also, we were reminded, as Liaisons, to get the committee minutes to Erin before our next PC meeting.
Stewardship/Time & Talent update	Kathy and Erin will meet on March 9th to discuss the Time and Talent part of Stewardship and how to present to the parish. Also discussed was a possible twice per year appeal for Time & Talent, and maybe a gathering where all committees would be available to answer questions and sign people up. Tammy remarked that we NEED to follow up with T&T; to keep connected with those who show interest.
Spiritual Soup for the Soul	Erin asked if any PC members attended the 1st evening on March 2. Darlene said it was well worth the time. Nicely presented and there was a LOT of Soup. Estimate of approx 50 attendees. St. T's PC is responsible for soup, bread, crackers for the MARCH 23rd meeting. Liaison for Adult/Family Ministry	Darlene will again try to attend and be the liaison for this Committee, but hopes that someone else would be willing to take over at the beginning of next cycle.
Call for More/DISCIPLE MAKER INDEX	Darlene reported that as of today, 3/4/20 we have had 36 people who have completed the survey. She explained a push to get the CFM parents aware and involved. Father will be announcing the importance of the survey at all the Masses this weekend 3/7-8 and Darlene, Pete and Newel will be handing out paper copies for those who may not want to do it online. Judy put the information on St. T's FaceBook page and there has been a positive response.
Capital Campaign Progress	Pete gave the current figures that were raised for the Fellowship Hall and explained that more pledges are coming in. He explained the Archdiocese process and where St. T's is with the necessary forms; the architectural considerations with the Reconciliation room placement. Pete is pleased at the progress being made and asked for continued support from the Pastoral Council. Also discussed was any "fundraisers" for certain items.
