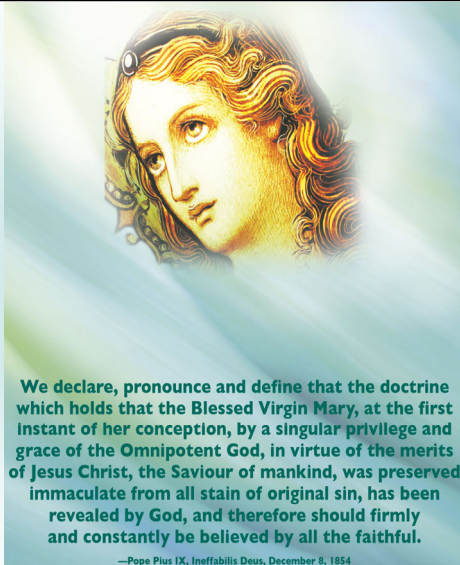

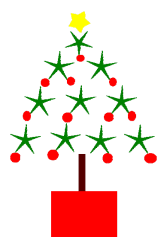




Navarre H S Concert Choir

First Sunday of Advent Watch Out!

In Advent, we celebrate our hope that the Lord might come more fully into our lives. The first reading from Isaiah voices the hope of sinners for a redeemer. Unlike Isaiah, we know that God has come to bring us back, when the Father sent his Son, Jesus, to save us. Our faith in Jesus leads us to a new way of looking at the world. We can see what God is doing as well as remembering what God has done.

Like the gatekeepers in Jesus' Gospel parable, we need to keep our eyes open for him. When we only look out for ourselves, we may miss the signs of God's presence around us. Instead of looking at the difficulties of life as obstacles, we can watch for them as opportunities to stretch our faith, to rely on God, or to show God's love to a friend. The recent re-translation of the prayers of the Mass can be an opportunity to stretch our faith and our understanding of the Eucharist.

The Corinthians were also watching for the Lord to come. They were thinking of Jesus as coming in glory. Though we don't see the full glory of the Lord, part of that glory is his presence in the sacraments. In them we celebrate not just the coming of the Lord, but his working in the world. He shares his life with us in baptism, gives us his Spirit in confirmation and himself in the Eucharist, heals us in reconciliation and the anointing of the sick, and calls us to make him present to others in holy orders and matrimony. You could almost say his second coming is taking place now.

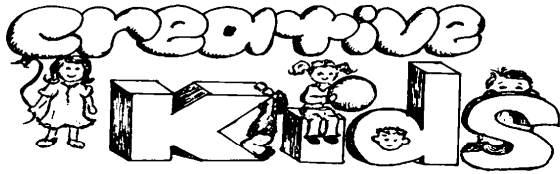

Clay Dough Advent Wreath

Directions:

1. Mix 3 cups all-purpose flour, 1 cup salt, and 2 TBS of cornstarch. Gradually add 1 1/4 cups water and 2 tsp. of cooking oil. Knead clay dough until smooth.
2. Divide dough in half. Add green food coloring to one half and knead until evenly colored.
3. Divide other half in half. Add purple food coloring and knead as before.
4. Divide the rest in half. Add pink to one half and yellow to the other half and knead separately.
5. Make the wreath out of the green dough, 3 candles out of the purple, 1 candle out of the pink, and 4 candle lights out of the yellow.
6. Place the wreath on a plate. Place the candles evenly spaced in the wreath. Light one of the purple candles.
7. Keep the rest of the candle lights in a plastic bag until they need to be placed on the appropriate candle on the next 3 Sundays.

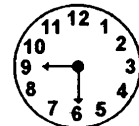

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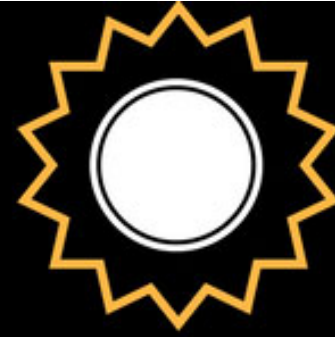
Society of St. Vincent de Paul

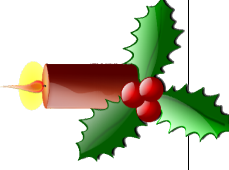
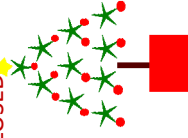
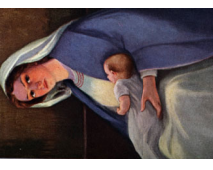
Noche Familiar
