UPDATE ON SOCIETY OF ST. VINCENT DE PAUL

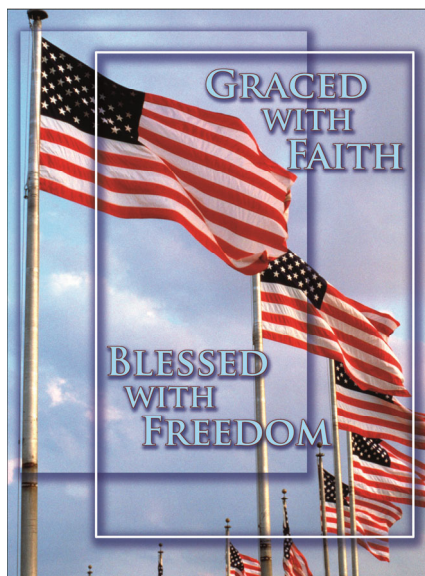
It may be summer but we are carrying on with our regular St. Vincent de Paul schedule of events and meetings. We gather on the first Tuesday evening of the month and the third Saturday morning of the month when holidays do not demand changing our schedule. We will have a supper gathering after the 4:00pm Mass on September 9th. We hope to have prospective members attend and all of those who have recently expressed interest in joining. We will provide a brief orientation so people can learn about what we do and what objectives are set for a parish conference (group). This is an international organization with prescribed rules, regulations and goals for its members and groups. This will be a chance for people to learn what the Society is all about. September 9th is the feast of one of our patrons so a day when Vincentians will attend Mass as a group. We would love to share what we are about and what we do and hope many of you will join us to learn and to share supper with us.

The friends of the Poor walk will be held on September 30th and many of us will be walking with others at Catholic High to show our support for meeting the needs of the poor in Escambia and Santa Rosa Counties. Any money donated in the name of our conference will come directly to us to aid in our work in South Santa Rosa County. Please consider walking or donating.

The Visiting Saints group of our St. Vincent de Paul conference has taken hold of serving the needs of many who need visitors. It was decided to detach from our conference and be a St. Sylvester ministry, as that seemed a better route to go for this particular offshoot of St. Vincent de Paul.

We will be hosting a class called GETTING AHEAD, which is an offshoot of the program Bridges out of Poverty. We will have 12 meetings at our parish and those attending the class to learn life skills for helping their financial situation will receive a small stipend for each night of attendance and will be provided dinner. Participants will be matched with mentors who will work with them on meeting goals of budgeting and planning. Members of the parish may wish to help out by providing food for one of the evening sessions. To achieve success with this program, we will need the help of many.

July 15th will be the day we prepare our brown bag lunches after our meeting. The distribution will be in the afternoon of Sunday, July 15th. We are trying to adhere to our every other month schedule for our lunch giveaways. We spend about \$250 of our money for each of these events and would be grateful to have donations to cover the cost since our money has to be divided so many ways in order to meet the requests we receive. Help us, please, to do the work of St. Vincent de Paul.
