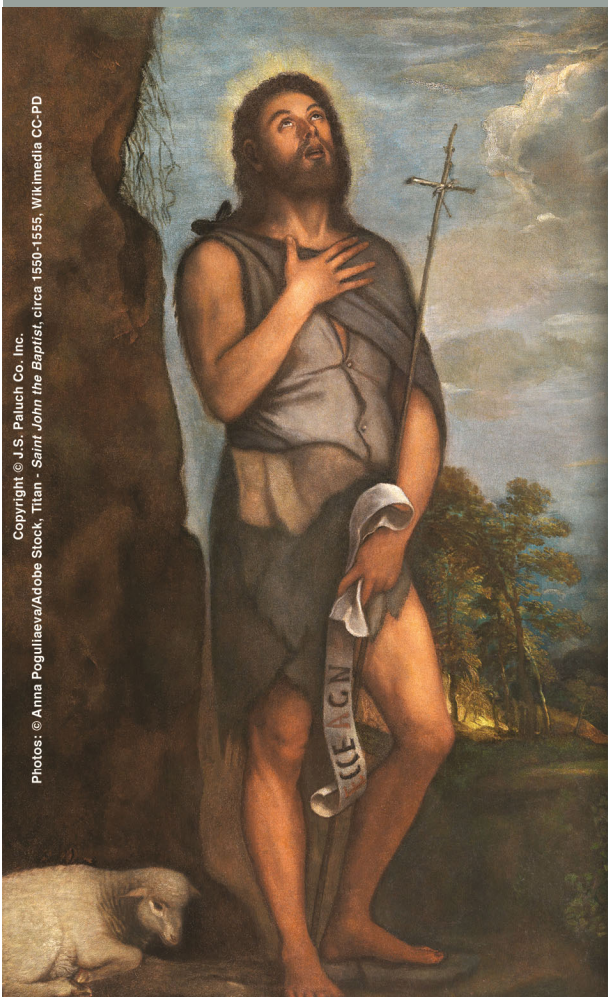

## SUMMER CHRISTMAS

One day Jesus was speaking about John the Baptist, telling people what a great prophet John was because he was doing exactly what God wanted him to do. Jesus ended by saying, "I tell you, among those born of women, no one is greater than John; yet the least in the kingdom of God is greater than he" (Luke 7:28). When we were baptized, we became part of God's kingdom. Jesus was talking about you and me. We are called to be even greater than this amazing man. John was the one who prepared the way for Jesus the Light. John was the one who baptized people to make them ready for the Messiah. On this solemn day, also known as Midsummer Day, let us remember John's life. Think about what you can do to become "even greater than John!"

The Nativity of St. John is sometimes called "Summer Christmas," because six months ago we celebrated the birth of Jesus. This is one of the longest days of the year, just as Christmas is one of the shortest. Make this a special night for your family. Spend some time outside tonight recalling the two symbols of John the Baptist—fire and water.

Catch some fireflies. (Be sure to let them go at the end of the evening!) With an adult, light your wood burner or grill. After dinner, roast marshmallows to remind you of the sweet honey John ate in the desert. Drink ice water or lemonade. Add to the menu below. Be sure everyone has a part in the planning!

**Save the date** for the return visiting missionaries from the Diocese of Wichita Totus Tuus for St. Sylvester 2018 VBS Monday **July 30-Friday August 3!** This missionary program encompasses whole parishes as a “totally” Catholic summer program for first grade through high school. Totus Tuus is coming back to St. Sylvester for its second year.

St Sylvester is piloting this program and working with the Diocese to develop a team of missionaries to a dozen area parishes in the Diocese of Pensacola Tallahassee next year!

Totus Tuus (Latin for “totally yours,” the papal motto of Pope St. John Paul II) celebrated its 31st anniversary in 2018. Originally developed by a seminarian in the Diocese of Wichita, KS, the week-long program is now taught by seminarians and college student missionaries who live, eat, and work with parish families. It has now spread to 27 dioceses in 15 states and Canada, mostly by word of mouth.

The missionary approach to parish evangelization combines catechesis with personal witness.

The youth participating in Totus Tuus week are immersed in living a whole new way of life that includes daily Mass, extended periods of prayer, and study of both Scripture and theology, transforming their understanding of our faith.

Bringing in the missionaries made a huge impact at St. Sylvester because there were young adults fully present all week, setting an example as a united group, who truly live out their faith. Their youthfulness, energy, and ability to witness to the Faith make them particularly effective with our young people.

The team serves for a week in the parish and facilitates two programs. Registration is \$10.

The elementary session for rising 1st-6th grade is from 8:00 am -2:00 pm and includes lunch. Middle and high school students are encouraged to assist during that time and stay for the day through to the middle and high school session. During the downtime in the afternoon the youth help with meal prep and plan for their Friday night talent show. They are provided dinner.

The middle and high school session is for rising 7th-12th graders from 6:30-8:45 pm. Those who help with the elementary school morning session, work the entire day and are first 40 youth, registered and paid, will be able to take a day trip to The Park at OWA Saturday August 4!

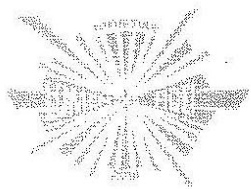

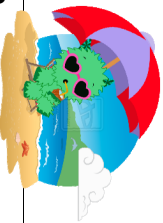
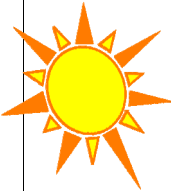
