
St. Sylvester Parish Annual Report July 1, 2021 to June 30, 2022


Parish Rolls



Income Statement and New Budget

As you can see above, our adjusted budget, which was adjusted to reflect cost increases beyond our control, shows a budgeted net loss of \$104,000. However, we ended the year with only a net loss of \$31,939. Our utilities were \$12,000 more than the year before, maintenance costs were \$32,000 more than the year before and our costs from operations were \$44,000 more than the year before. There are some costs that we can control, and we have done everything we can to keep these costs down as much as possible. We would rather end the year with a loss, if needed, than to not have the many programs and services available to you. We can absorb the net loss for one year. While we did start last year expecting a net loss, our budget for the current year has a net gain of \$55,500. We are starting off this fiscal year in a much better position.


