Now that the governor has mandated schools to remain closed for the rest of the school year, our staff is hard at work coming up with our plans moving forward. This pandemic has drastically changed all of our lives in so many ways; however, one thing remains the same. Our teachers and staff are dedicated to meeting the needs of your children. To do this we are making a slight change to our weekly schedule. We will begin to use Fridays as a "Specials Day" & Teacher Support Day. That means that by next week all of our teachers will be planning instruction and activities for Monday-Thursday.
