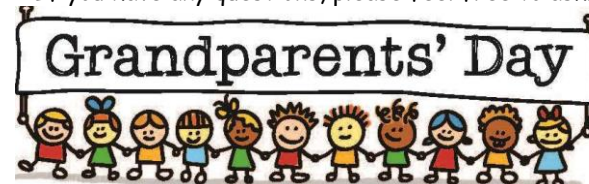


**Grandparents Day**
