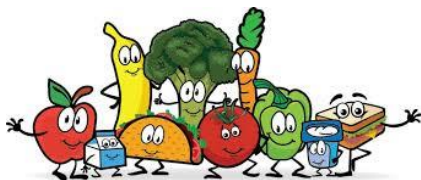

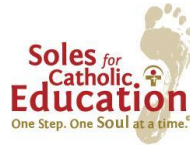
### No School October 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> – Teacher Inservice
