Mark your calendars for next week Monday, March 12th. On the 12th, we have a Strategic Planning Meeting to help us develop goals for the next three to five years. I can't wait to begin the planning process for our wonderful school. It is so important that we take inventory of our strengths and weaknesses so that we can set forth a detailed plan for growth and improvement. All are Welcome! The meeting begins at 7:00pm in the school basement.

One of the topics that has been brought to the forefront, due to recent school violence, is the safety of our students and staff. Please know that DSCS is doing everything possible to ensure that our campus is safe. This week Wednesday, I will be attending a program titled *SAFE (Sanctuary Actions for Emergencies) and POWER (Place Of Worship Emergency Response)* offered by the Hartford Police Department. We are also working closely with the Ozaukee County Sheriff's Office to review our policies and procedures and to set goals for the physical safety of our campus.

It is Iowa Basic Testing time at DSCS. All of our students in grades 5K-7th will be taking the tests over the next few weeks. The Iowa Tests are nationally normed standardized tests that offer our teachers a diagnostic look at how students are progressing in key academic areas. Once we receive the results of the testing, our staff looks closely at the data to help us plan for instruction and to better meet the needs of each individual student.

Be sure to stop downstairs at Second Sunday Donuts on March 11th to see our 4K students and their Teddy Bear Floats! We have some of the best 4K students around and they are excited to show-off their floats following the 10:00 Mass.

EMERGENCY CLOSING OF SCHOOL

Divine Savior Catholic School observes the closing of school as determined by the Northern Ozaukee School District in case of severe weather conditions. If Random Lake School District closes and Northern Ozaukee does not, all Random Lake bus students will be given an excused absence for the day missed. The announcement of school closing will be made through the NOSD SkyAlert phone system and the Divine Savior Catholic School network of phone calls. The announcement will be made as early as possible on the following radio stations and television channels:

- Radio: WTMJ (620AM) WOKY (920AM) WISN (1130AM)
- TV: WTMJ (CH 4) WITI (CH 6) WISN (CH 12) CBS (CH58)

On a TWO-HOUR DELAYED START, students should arrive no earlier than 15 minutes before classes begin. There is no supervision before that time. Every effort will be made to alert teachers to a school closing as early as possible. Many times the school does not know until the last possible time before the school buses are to go out. However, if the circumstances are such that the school secretary or principal can notify teachers well in advance, we shall do so. In case of an emergency situation within the building, the pastor and the principal will determine closing the school. Parents will be notified as soon as possible. There will be no a.m. Kindergarten for half-day students on delayed start days.



WHEN TO KEEP YOUR CHILD HOME:
