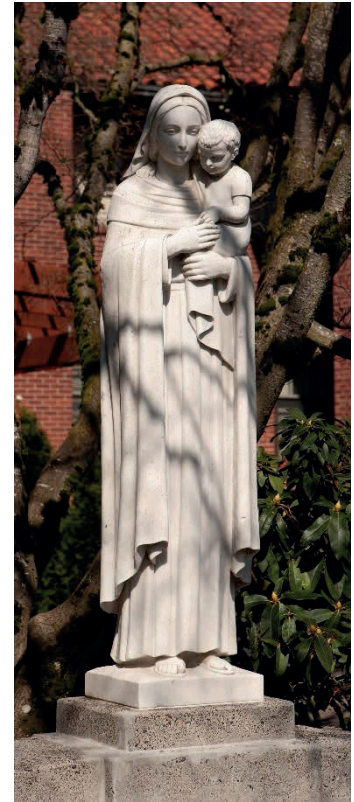

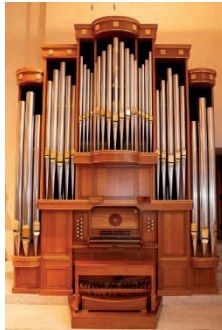
## ADORATION OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT

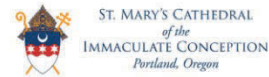

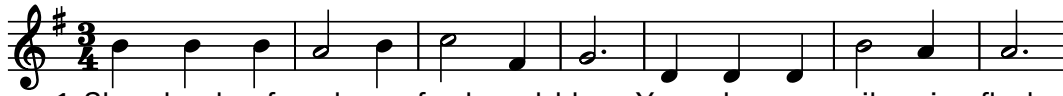
