If you are interested in childcare, your registration is necessary and is due by February 2. Childcare will be provided in Room #1 located on the lowest level of the Stemm Building (attached to the church). You may enter through O'Malley Hall to access the Childcare Room. Please arrive early enough to allow time to deliver children to the Childcare Room before settling in O'Malley Hall.

**Eucharist Centers**, for parents **and** their child preparing for First Communion, will be on February 29, March 1, or 2. Please register for this online as well by February 14.

On the reverse side of this letter you will also find First Communion policies. After reviewing this material, please begin to notify the Faith Formation Office at 582-0377 or online at [www.stanthony-dubuque.org](http://www.stanthony-dubuque.org), hold your mouse over "Sacraments, and "Sacramental Preparation" will appear in the drop down menu. Your reservation for your child's First Communion must be made by April 15. Nativity parishioners are automatically registered for the May 3 date.

During these weeks as we prepare together for your child's First Communion, please be sure to bring your child to Sunday Mass and take the time to talk with your child often about the Eucharist, read Bible stories together, and pray together.
