This year your child will be celebrating First Holy Communion and First Reconciliation. Our sacramental preparation program has a family perspective to support you in preparing your child for these very important times in his/her faith journey, as well as to deepen your own experience and understanding of Reconciliation and Eucharist.

The foundation of this sacramental program is the conviction that as parents/guardians, you carry out the primary role in the religious formation of your children simply by being parents/guardians - the most important adults and Christians in your children's lives. We recognize that truth and want to support you in your ministry.

The Family Sacramental Program begins with an **Enrollment Ceremony** for you and your child and also includes two sets of essential meetings prior to the celebration of each sacrament:

- 1. Reconciliation Parent Meeting & Reconciliation Centers
- 2. Eucharist Parent Meeting & Eucharist Centers
