

The Resumption of Public Masses



On Thursday, May 21, Bishop Persico announced that the celebration of Public Mass may resume on June 1, 2020 in places where the following guidelines can be observed:

The members of the congregation wear face masks, social distancing be practiced, only 1/3 of occupancy of the church building be used, and the church be cleaned after each celebration.

With everyone's cooperation, Immaculate Heart can follow these guidelines.

Mass will be celebrated Monday, June 1, 2020 at 7 pm in honor of the Memorial of Mary, Mother of the Church. The 8:00 am daily Mass will resume on Tuesday, June 2, 2020. Sunday Masses will resume the weekend of June 6 and 7, 2020. Mass will be celebrated Saturday, June 6, 2020 at 5 pm and Sunday, June 7, 2020 at 8:00 am and 10:30 am. For the time being, Mass will continue to be broadcast on Facebook live for the benefit of those who can not attend in person, Sunday afternoons at 2:30 pm. This Mass may be attended in person as well, providing another opportunity for people to attend and observe the guidelines set forth.

Bishop Persico continues to dispense the faithful from the Sunday obligation meaning that you **ARE NOT** expected to attend Mass on the weekend. If you are in a high risk category or are not well, please stay safe at home.

Patience will be required. Your favorite pew may not be available to sit in. If you arrive at church and find it to be "full", please keep in mind social distancing and perhaps consider attending a different Mass.
