

IHM COVID-19 Update



On Friday May 14, Bishop Persico announced further COVID guidance for parishes in the Diocese of Erie:

Effective immediately, parishes of the diocese may return to 100% use of capacity. At Immaculate Heart, we have begun using 100% of capacity.

Individuals are no longer required to wear masks when in church. Those who are not fully vaccinated are strongly encouraged to wear masks while in church, both for their protection and that of others.

For the time being, Bishop Persico continues to dispense from the Sunday obligation meaning that you **ARE NOT** expected to attend Mass on the weekend. If you are in a high risk category or are not well, please stay safe at home.

Should you arrive at church and be uncomfortable with the space available, overflow seating can still be found in Gallagher Hall.
