_____ Serve on the Liturgy Committee:

This ministry offers an opportunity to share your talents in an effort to deepen and strengthen the spiritual life and worship.

_____ Lector (Saturday/Sunday): Men, women, and confirmed teens who proclaim the Word of God at weekend Masses.

_____ Eucharistic Ministers: Men, women, and confirmed teens share their gifts by serving the Body and Blood of Christ to the people of God.

_____ Eucharistic Ministers to the homebound: Men, women, and confirmed teens share their gifts by serving the Body and Blood of Christ to the homebound.

_____ Sacristan (weekend): The sacristan prepares the “Lord’s Table” for weekend Masses including the hosts, wine, water, etc. Open to any registered parishioner confirmed in the church.

_____ Sacristan (funeral): This ministry has the same responsibility as Sacristan with the addition of serving as Eucharistic Minister when needed.

_____ Ushers (men, women, teens): This ministry includes assisting in any preparations, parishioner’s needs & procedural work requirements of the liturgy.

_____ Greeters (men, women & teens): This ministry includes opening the doors and welcoming and greeting so everyone feels at home.

_____ Altar Servers (4th-12th grade): The Server assists the priest at weekend Masses.

_____ Adult Server (weekday/funeral): Men or women servers to assist the priest for a funeral or a weekday Mass.

_____ Offertory Gift-bearers (men, women or families): This ministry is to carry up the bread and wine along with monetary offerings.
