Sponsor and Candidate:

Please be in the East Wing of the Parish Center 45 minutes prior to the Mass!

Everyone is Welcome! The doors of the church will open **one hour** prior to Mass.

Dress: In recognizing and keeping with the dignity of the occasion, we expect all that attend to dress appropriately. The Candidates will not be wearing robes. The Candidates will each be given a ribbon and pin to wear on their clothing. We will not be giving out flowers, but the Candidates may wear a corsage or boutonniere if you choose.

Gentlemen Candidates: Dress shirt with tie and dress pants.
No sneakers, jeans or T-shirts.

Lady Candidates: Dress skirt or dress pants and top. Please, no tank tops or spaghetti straps.
Hemlines, waistlines and necklines should be appropriate for church.
No sneakers, jeans or T-shirts.

Sponsors: Please be sure to ask your Sponsor to dress appropriately for the occasion. No sneakers, jeans or T-shirts. Appropriate hemlines, waistlines and necklines.

Pictures: We do not allow pictures to be taken during Confirmation Mass. That includes the use of digital, cell phone, video cameras and other devices. It is irreverent and distracting to this time of worship and prayer. Please be sure to let family members and friends know.

After Mass, the Bishop and Fr. Paul will be available for pictures with the Candidates and their families. Due to time constraints, we ask that each family limit their pictures to two (2) per family.
