



as you and Mary did.

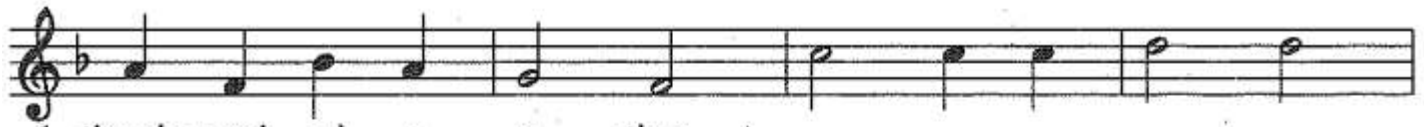
