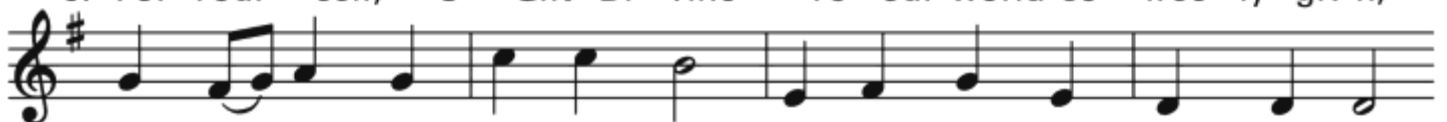

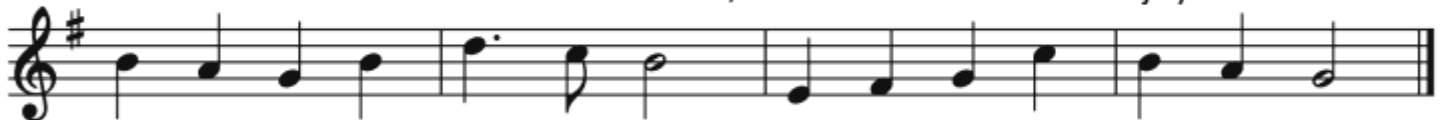

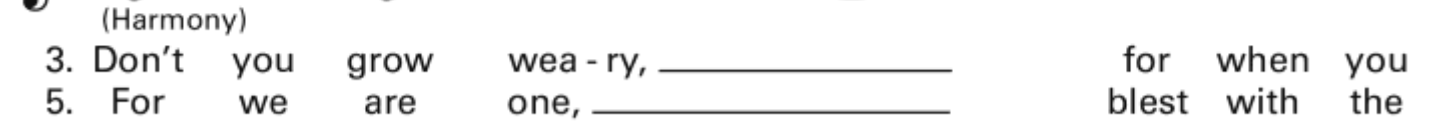

You know our need for priests.

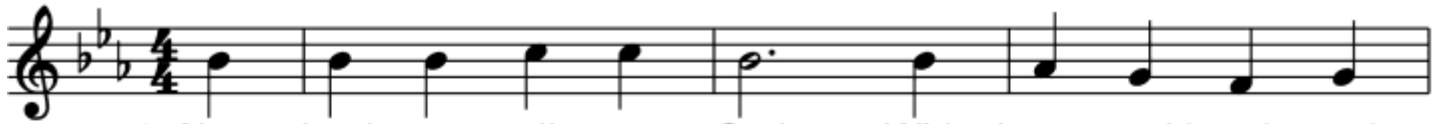
Please raise up good and holy priests from our families to serve the people of
