Tie Breaker Rules for Pool Play Ties

If 2 teams from the same pool are tied, then following will be used to determine the winner.

1. Their head to head match determines the order of finish
2. If still tied, fewest total points allowed head to head will determine order of finish
3. If still tied, one game tie breaker to 11 will be played. First team to 11 wins the tie breaker

If 3 or 4 teams from the same pool are tied, then the following will be used to determine the winner

1. Total points allowed will be determined for all head to head matches
2. Fewest total points allowed determines their order of finish
3. If still tied, one game tie breaker to 11 will be played as determined by Tournament Coordinator
