

Confirmation Program

The Confirmation program is a two - year program. There are 16 classes, eight in fall and eight in spring. There will be four large group classes held in church. The remaining 12 weeks will be divided into four three-week courses.

Each student will be able to choose five electives from the ten topics below. All students *will* take the Confirmation elective in their **junior year**. Every attempt will be made to assign the top four choices.

- BEING CATHOLIC – Review of Catholic Beliefs
- CHURCH HISTORY
- CONFIRMATION (not available to Sophomore students)
- LITURGY – Inside the Sunday Mass and the church building
- MARY & THE SAINTS
- NEW TESTAMENT
- OLD TESTAMENT
- PRAYER – The Practice of Prayer
- SACRAMENTS – The Sacraments of Initiation, Service and Healing
- STEWARDSHIP – Our role in the church

Please keep in mind:

- The classes will be filled in the order the forms/emails are received.
- There is no guarantee that you will have your choices in the order you have chosen, but all efforts will be made that you get your first four choices during the course of the year.
- Once classes have been assigned, there will be no changes made.
- We will not be able to accommodate requests of students being placed with friends.
- If you do not turn in your choices, topics will be selected for you.
